



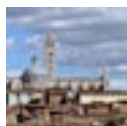

<p>Sun 22 March 2026</p> 	<p><b>ARRIVE IN ROME</b>  <b>Location:</b> Rome</p> <p>On arrival you will be met by a friendly local representative who will hand over your 2-days Metro-bus passes and who will escort you to your coach and transfer to your accommodation. The remainder of the day will be for sightseeing at teachers' discretion. Ideas of places to go in Rome are Pantheon, Piazza del popolo, Trevi Fountain, the Spanish Steps, Piazza Navona, Piazza di Spagna. Enjoy a 2-course dinner at a local restaurant - drinks not included.</p>
<p>Mon 23 March 2026</p> 	<p><b>GUIDED TOUR OF ANCIENT ROME</b>  <b>Location:</b> The Colosseum, Piazza del Colosseo, Rome, Metropolitan City of Rome, Italy</p> <p>Meet your guide at The Colosseum who will take you on an awe inspiring walking tour of ancient Rome, including the entrance to The Colosseum, which is the largest Ancient Amphitheatre in the world and The Roman Forum. This was the scene of public meetings, law courts, and gladiatorial combats in republican times.</p> <p>The rest of the day is free under the guidance of your teachers.</p> <p>Dinner is included tonight.</p>
<p>Tues 24 March 2026</p>   	<p><b>GALLERIA BORGHESE</b>  <b>Location:</b> Galleria Borghese, Piazzale Scipione Borghese, Rome, Metropolitan City of Rome Capital, Italy</p> <p>Experience some of the world's greatest art in an intimate setting. The Galleria is housed in the Borghese family's former villa and features a stunning collection of art and sculpture from the Renaissance and Baroque periods.</p> <p>Some of the most notable pieces in the Galleria Borghese include works by Caravaggio, Bernini, and Raphael.</p> <p><b>GUIDED TOUR OF THE VATICAN CITY</b>  <b>Location:</b> Vatican City</p> <p>Enjoy a guided visit of the Vatican Museums that will allow you to view their impressive collection, including the extraordinary ceiling of the Sistine Chapel. Continue on to the magnificent St Peter's Square and visit St. Peter's Basilica with its many treasures and masterpieces including Michelangelo's famous Pietà.</p>

**Location:** Sienna, Province of Siena, Italy

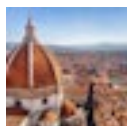





## ART WORKSHOP, GALLERIA DELL'ACCADEMIA AND BRANCACCI CHAPEL

**Location:** Accademia Gallery, Via Ricasoli, Florence, Metropolitan City of Florence, Italy

After breakfast, students will take part into a captivating 4-hour art workshop hosted in a fully equipped studio. In the afternoon, the group will embark on a visit to the prestigious Galleria dell'Accademia, where they can admire the renowned sculptures, including Michelangelo's iconic "David." This will be followed by a guided tour to the Brancacci Chapel, where the intricate frescoes tell compelling stories of artistic brilliance and historical significance.

<p>Sat 28 March 2026</p> 	<p><b>EXCURSION TO PISA</b>  <b>Location:</b> Pisa, Province of Pisa, Italy</p> <p>Following breakfast, stroll to the Santa Maria Novella train station to commence your journey from Florence to Pisa which is nestled in the heart of Tuscany, is renowned for its Leaning Tower, an architectural marvel in the picturesque Piazza dei Miracoli. Beyond the iconic tower, the city boasts a rich historical tapestry, including the Pisa Cathedral and vibrant medieval streets. Your teachers will organise a drawing workshop inspired by your location.</p> <p>Dinner is included tonight.</p>
<p>Sun 29 March 2026</p> 	<p><b>OPEN AIR ART WORKSHOP - PIZZA AND GELATO MAKING CLASS</b>  <b>Location:</b> Florence, Metropolitan City of Florence, Italy</p> <p>Start your day with a 4-hour outdoor art workshop inspired by some of the beautiful sights. The afternoon is free for visits under your teachers' guidance, and later in the day, enjoy a delightful Pizza and Gelato cooking class in the heart of Florence and eat your delicious creations for dinner.</p>
<p>Mon 30 March 2026</p> 	<p><b>FLORENCE - VENICE</b></p> <p>After breakfast and check out, be met by your coach and transfer Firenze Santa Maria Novella train station and board your Freccia Rossa train to Venice Santa Lucia. Upon arrival in Venice, walk to your accommodation and drop your luggage (check in available later in the afternoon). Start exploring Venice under the guidance of your teachers. You will be able to collect the hard copies of your 48-hrs Vaporetto passes directly from the ticket office located at the train station. Dinner included.</p>
<p>Tues 31 March 2026</p> 	<p><b>VENICE</b>  <b>Location:</b> Venice, Metropolitan City of Venice, Italy</p> <p>After breakfast and explore Venice by using your Vaporetto passes to reach St. Mark's Square. Immerse yourself in a comprehensive 2-hour guided walking tour, encompassing the awe-inspiring Bridge of Sighs, the majestic Doge's Palace (with included entrance and reservation fees), and the iconic St. Mark's Basilica (with entrance and reservation fees covered). The rest of the day is yours to discover Venice under the thoughtful guidance of your teachers, culminating in a delightful dinner at a local restaurant.</p>
<p>Wed 1 April 2026</p> 	<p><b>DEPART FOR AUSTRALIA</b>  <b>Location:</b> Venice, Metropolitan City of Venice, Italy</p> <p>After breakfast and check out, walk to the closest pier to your hotel for your private water taxi transfer to Venice Marco Polo airport or transfer to Milan for your flight home.</p>
